1. What is a cookie?

Cookies are small text files that are generated by the Websites that You are viewing, allowing the concerned Website to store information as You navigate web pages. These text files contain session data that can be useful to improve Your browsing experience. Session-based cookies last only while Your browser is open and are automatically deleted when You close Your browser. Persistent cookies last until You or Your browser delete them or until they expire.

All the cookies used by the Websites are safe for Your computer and they only store information that is used by the browser. These cookies cannot execute code and cannot be used to access content on Your computer. Many of these cookies are necessary to ensure the proper functioning of the Website. They do not contain malware or viruses.

Cookies, by themselves, do not tell us any personally identifiable information.

2. What is the purpose of our cookies?

We use cookies for the following purposes:

Purpose	Explanation
Authentication	If You're signed in to our Services, cookies help us show You the right information and personalize Your experience.
Security	We use cookies to enable and support our security features, and to help us detect malicious activity.

Preferences, features, and services	Cookies can tell us which language You prefer as well as information about previously viewed content. They also provide You with features and other insights.
Marketing	We may use cookies to be able to target advertising to a specific user at the correct time to make it as relevant as possible for You. We may also use cookies to help us deliver marketing campaigns and track their performance (e.g., a user visited our support and then made a purchase). Similarly, our partners may use cookies to provide us with information about Your interactions with their services, but use of those third-party cookies would be subject to the service provider's policies.
Performance, Analytics and Research	Cookies help us learn how well our Websites and Services perform. We also use cookies to understand, improve, and research products, features, and services, including to create logs and record when You access our Websites and Services from different devices, such as Your work computer or Your mobile device. This information is stored by cookies and used to enhance user experience, such as identifying and resolving errors and navigation problems.
Statistics	To enhance our understanding of Your interaction with our Websites, we may use cookies to collect data for statistical purposes, including (but not limited to): date of first visit, number of visits, date of last visit, URL, browser, and screen resolution.

3. What third-party cookies do we use?

We may partner with third-party ad networks to either display advertising on our Websites or to manage our advertising on other websites. Our ad network partners use cookies and web beacons to collect non-personally identifiable information about Your activities on this and other websites to show You targeted advertising based on Your interests. We may also partner with third-party data providers to match IP addresses with company names and contact names. You may voluntarily de-activate and/or eliminate cookies by following Your Internet browser's instructions. If You limit the ability of the Websites and Software to set cookies, You may worsen Your overall user experience and/or lose the ability to access the Services.
